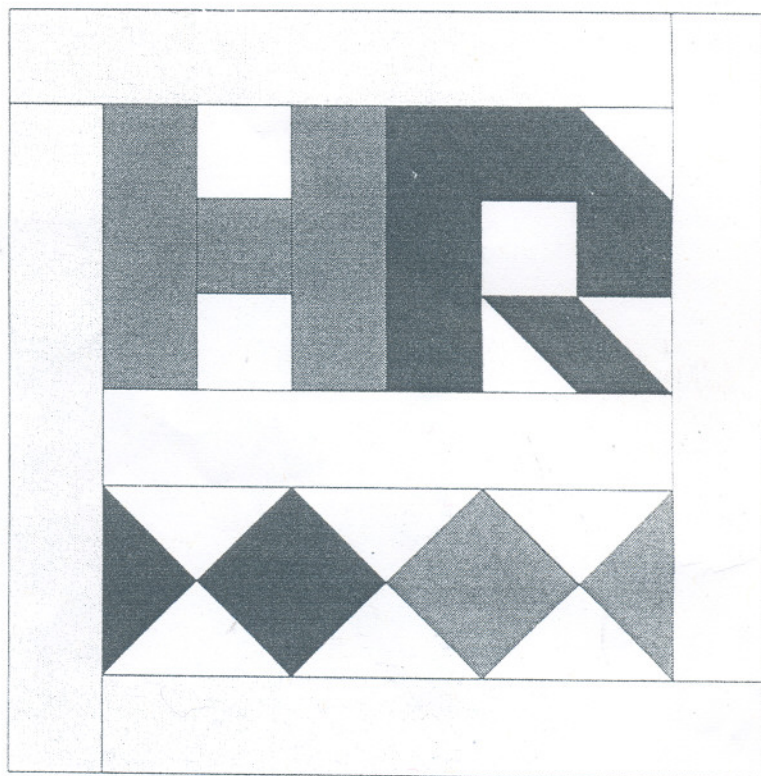
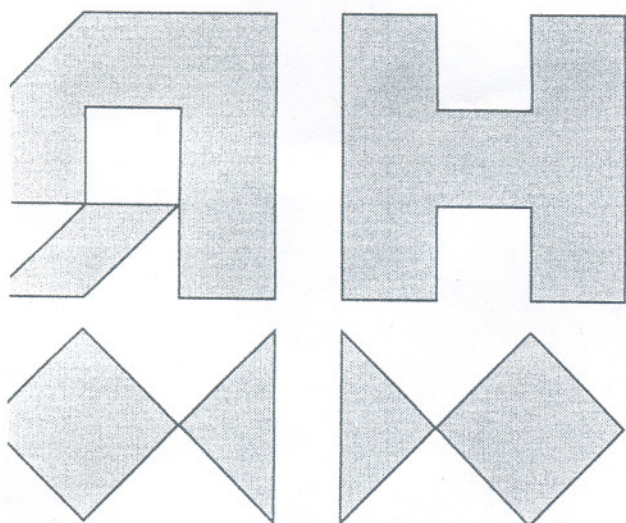
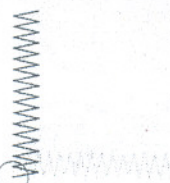


# Herring Run Quilters Guild Name Badge



1. Trace the items onto your bonding medium. Be sure to trace your images backward, because they are going to be ironed on to the wrong side of your fabrics.
2. Adhere bonding medium to the wrong side of your fabrics. Cut out shapes.
3. Place shapes right side up on your background fabric, using the full-size badge as a guide.
4. Iron the shapes in place according to the binding agent directions.
5. Satin stitch around the edges, omitting the outside edges, as they will be encased by the border.
6. Sew border strips around edges. Add ribbon neck loop if desired when putting on batting and backing.

When making a clockwise turn, leave needle in the fabric at the right-hand swing.



When making a counter-clockwise turn, leave needle in the fabric at the left-hand swing.
