

Herring Run Quilters Guild

Block of the month November 2018

All quilt blocks for the 2018-2019 guild year will be made in very bright colors of your choosing! All backgrounds will be either on white or white on white print.

Morning Star (12" finished) Bring block to December meeting!

Cutting Instructions:

Finished Product →

Colors A, B, and C any color and should all be different. Color D is the background

Color A: 2- 5" squares. Cut once on diagonal to make 4 half square triangles.

Color B: 2- 5 ¼" squares. Cut twice on diagonal to make 8 quarter square triangles.

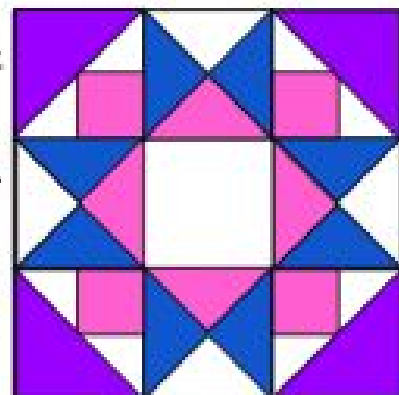
Color C: 4- 2 ½" squares

1- 5 ¼" square. Cut twice on diagonal to make 4 quarter square triangles.

Color D: 4- 3" squares. Cut once on diagonal to make 8 half square triangles.

1- 5 ¼" squares. Cut twice on diagonal to make 4 quarter square triangles.

1- 4 ½" square (for the center)



In the diagrams below, Color A is Purple, Color B is Blue, Color C is Pink, and Color D is white.

Assembly Instructions:

Side Units: (make 4)

-Sew color B triangle to an equal sized color D triangle. Make sure Color B is on the left. Press toward darker fabric.

-Sew color B triangle to an equal sized color C triangle. Make sure Color B is on the left. Press toward darker fabric.

-Sew these two units together to form a square. See diagram to make sure color placement is correct. Trim to 4 ½".

REPEAT THESE STEPS 4 TIMES TO MAKE 4- 4 ½" SQUARES!

Corner Units: (make 4)

-Sew 2 small color D triangles to a color C square. See diagram to make sure placement is correct. Press toward triangles.

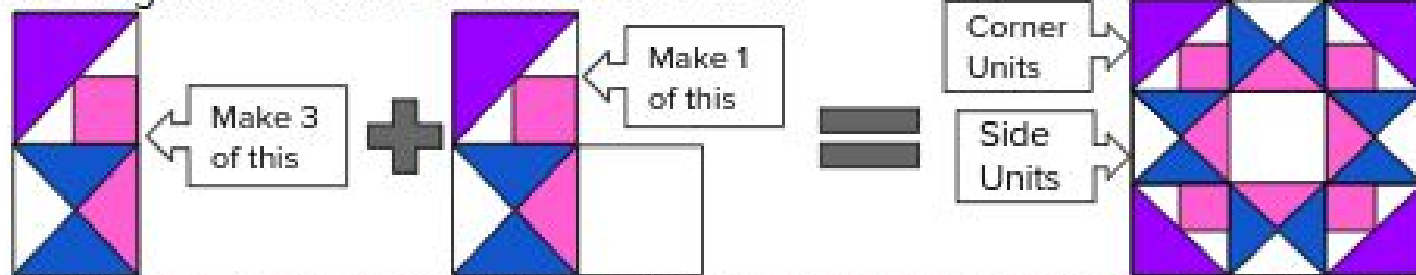
-Add a color A triangle to form a square. Press toward Color A.

Trim to 4 ½".

REPEAT THESE STEPS 4 TIMES TO MAKE 4- 4 ½" SQUARES!

Final Assembly:

-see diagrams below to assemble the block



We suggest that you make two blocks. Keep one each month and you will have 9 to make a quilt by June. Submit the other one at the next meeting to the block raffle. Winner takes all each month!
