

HRQG February 2022 Block of the Month - Celtic Squares



What you need to cut, from the picture!

White/off-white, background - 2 A, 4 B, 5 C, 4 F

Red, top left- 2 C, D, E

Blue, top right - 2 C, D, E

Purple, bottom left - 2 C, D, E

Green, bottom right - 2 C, D, E

Yellow, middle - 2 E, 2 A

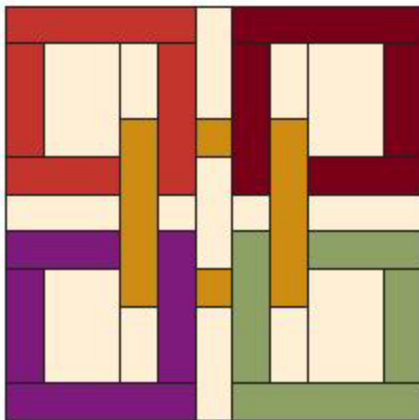
SEW and put aside:

- 3 Cs Red, white and Purple together RWP,
- 3 Cs Blue White and Green together BWG
- 4 CFs together red-white RW, Blue-white BW, Purple-white PW, and Green-white GW together.
- 2 BEB's white-yellow-white,
- 2 DAD's Red-white-purple and blue-white-green,
- 1 CACAC white-yellow-white-yellow-white

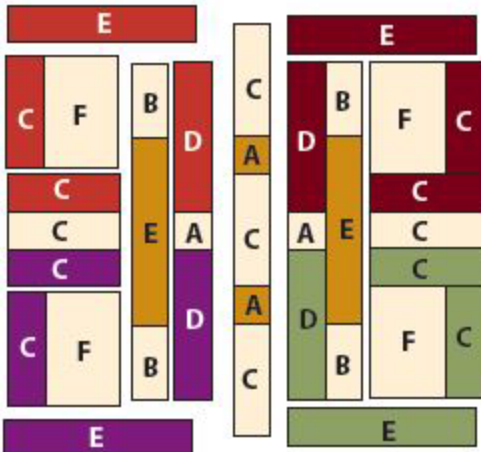
SEW together:

- red-white CF to Red-white-Purple 3 Cs, then sew purple-white CF to it.
- white-blue FC to blue-white-green 3Cs, then sew white-green FC to it
- white-yellow-white BEB to each of the above rectangles.
- Red-white-purple and blue-white-green to each of the rectangles above.
- Red, Blue, Purple and Green Es to the corresponding sides.
- white-yellow-white-yellow-white CACAC to one side
- then add the final rectangle.

This original block looks interwoven, but it couldn't be easier to cut and sew. The next page shows strip piecing. The quilt segment is presented in two color schemes. Join blocks with G sashes; join rows with long sashes cut 2-1/2" wide.



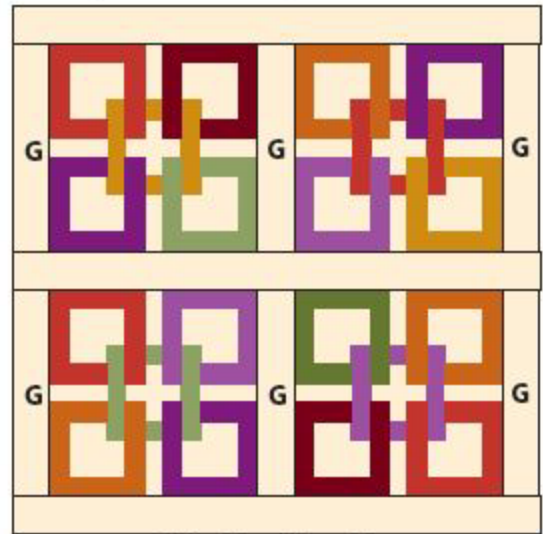
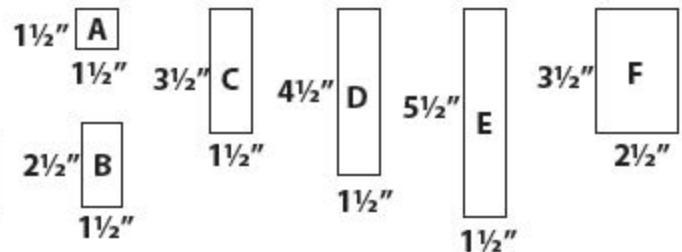
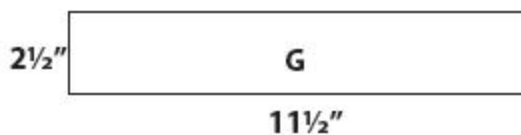

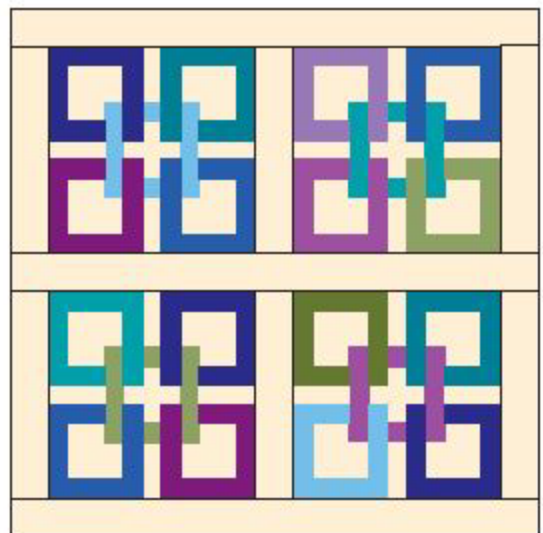
Block Piecing

Rotary Cutting Patches (See figures.)

- A. Cut strip 1 1/2"; cut square 1 1/2"
- B. Cut strip 1 1/2"; cut rectangle 2 1/2"
- C. Cut strip 1 1/2"; cut rectangle 3 1/2"
- D. Cut strip 1 1/2"; cut rectangle 4 1/2"
- E. Cut strip 1 1/2"; cut rectangle 5 1/2"
- F. Cut strip 2 1/2"; cut rectangle 3 1/2"
- G. Cut strip 2 1/2"; cut rectangle 11 1/2"
