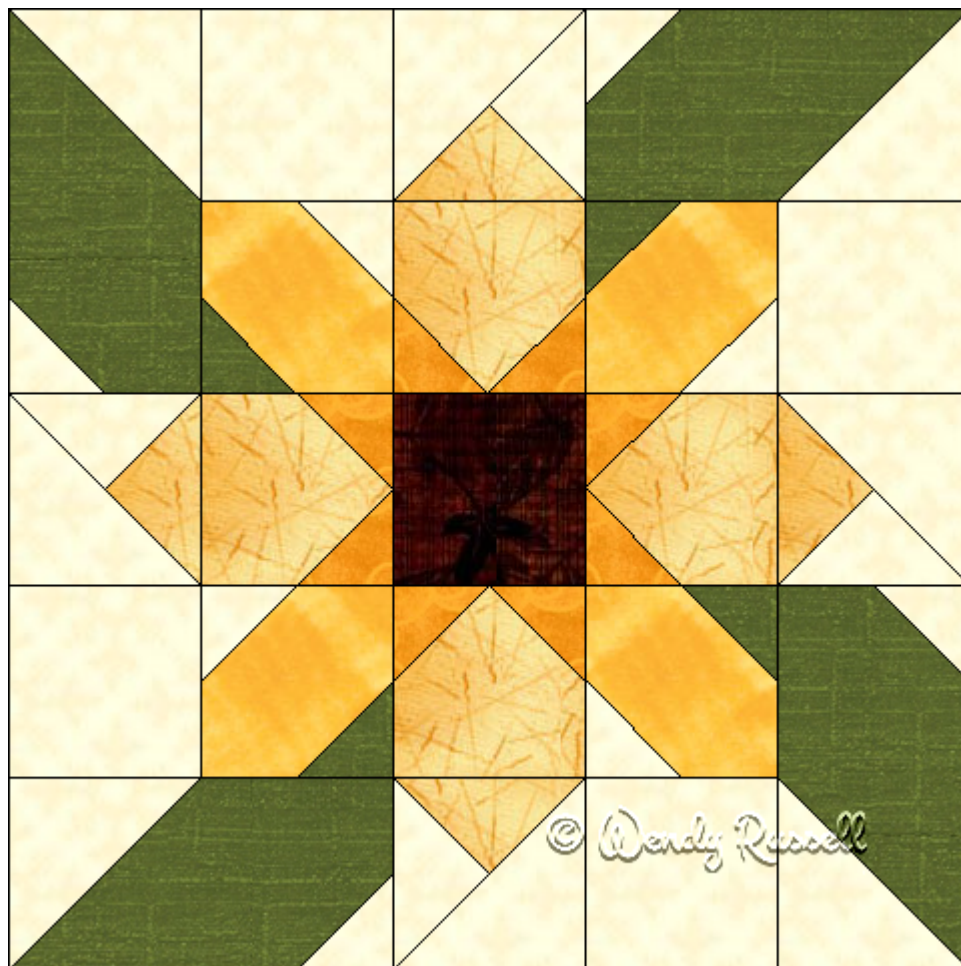
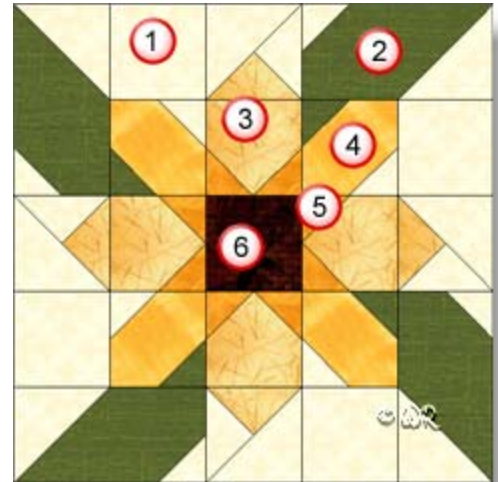

How-to Notes








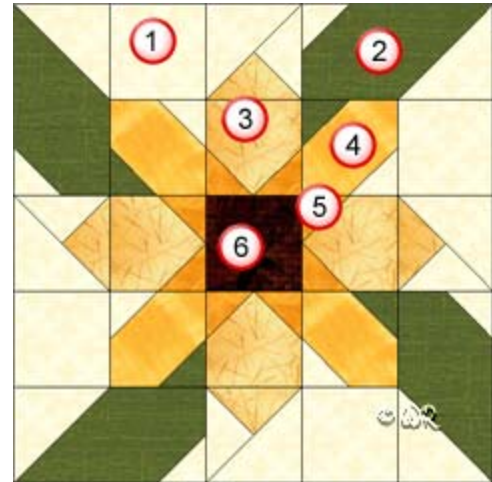
Bisect square on one diagonal



Bisect square on both diagonals

*All seam allowances are 1/4" unless noted otherwise

1		<p>Background fabric 1</p> <p>Cut 8 squares 3 1/2"</p> <p>Cut 8 squares 2"</p> <p>Cut 2 squares 3 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal</p> <p>Cut 1 square 4 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals</p>
2		<p>Fabric 2</p> <p>Cut 4 rectangles 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"</p> <p>Cut 4 squares 2"</p>
3		<p>Fabric 3</p> <p>Cut 4 squares 3 1/2"</p> <p>Cut 1 square 4 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals</p>
4		<p>Fabric 4</p> <p>Cut 4 squares 3 1/2"</p>
5		<p>Fabric 5</p> <p>Cut 8 squares 2"</p>
6		<p>Fabric 6</p> <p>Cut 1 square 3 1/2" for centre</p>

Bisect square on one diagonal



Bisect square on both diagonals

*All seam allowances are 1/4" unless noted otherwise

1		<p>Background fabric 1</p> <p>Cut 8 squares 2 1/2"</p> <p>Cut 8 squares 1 1/2"</p> <p>Cut 2 squares 2 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal</p> <p>Cut 1 square 3 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals</p>
2		<p>Fabric 2</p> <p>Cut 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"</p> <p>Cut 4 squares 1 1/2"</p>
3		<p>Fabric 3</p> <p>Cut 4 squares 2 1/2"</p> <p>Cut 1 square 3 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals</p>
4		<p>Fabric 4</p> <p>Cut 4 squares 2 1/2"</p>
5		<p>Fabric 5</p> <p>Cut 8 squares 1 1/2"</p>
6		<p>Fabric 6</p> <p>Cut 1 square 2 1/2" for centre</p>

Arrow Points



Make 4

"Leaf" patch - make 4 units



1 - Draw pencil line, corner to corner on wrong side of square

2 - Sew on pencil line



3 - Flip fabric to corner

4 - Repeat process for small square in opposite corner



5 - Finished, pressed patch

**You may wish to trim excess fabric behind visible triangles*

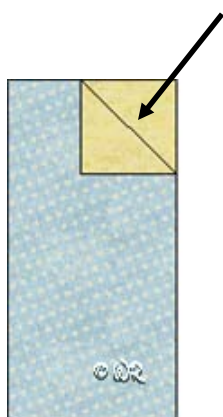

Patchwork Square

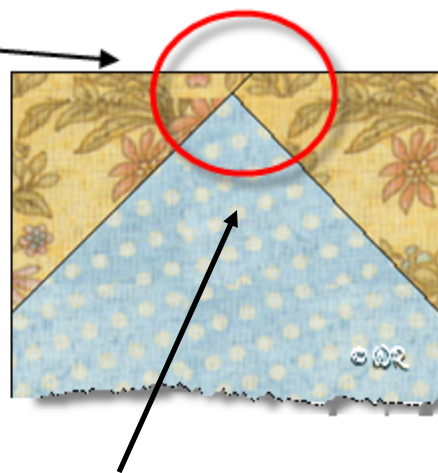
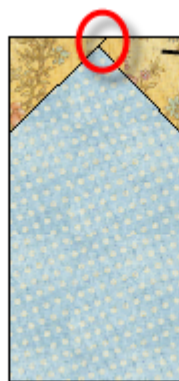
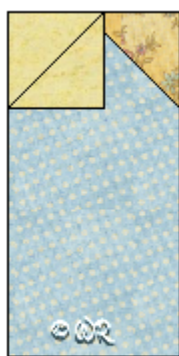
Free Quilt Block Pattern

“Arrow” Points — No triangle method—using only squares

1. Draw pencil line, corner to corner on wrong side of small square
2. Place fabrics right sides together
3. Sew on drawn pencil line
4. Press to outer edge



5. Repeat process for second corner

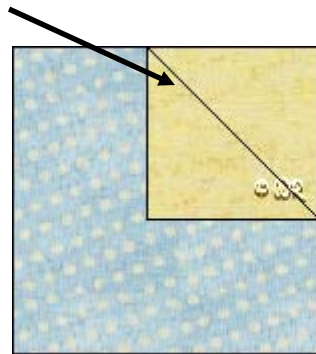


**** Important Sewing Note ****

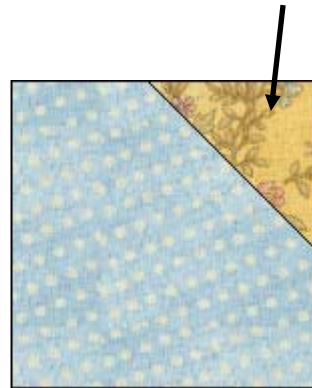
“Arrow” Point of rectangle does not reach outer edge — to allow for the seam allowance for next seam

“Triangles in Opposite Corners” — Method, using only squares

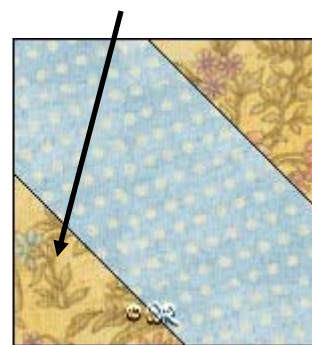
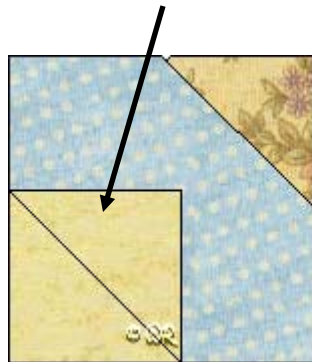
1. Draw pencil line, corner to corner on wrong side of small square
2. Place fabrics right sides together
3. Sew on drawn pencil line



4. Press to outer edge

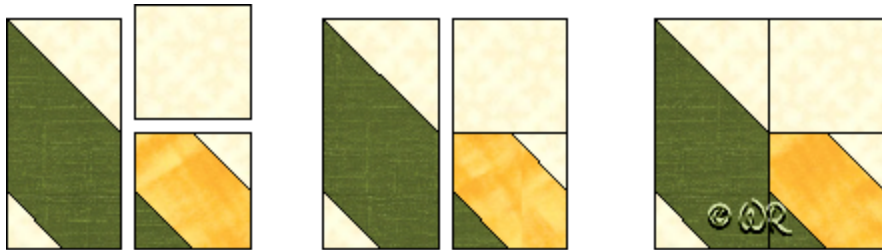


5. Repeat process for opposite corner

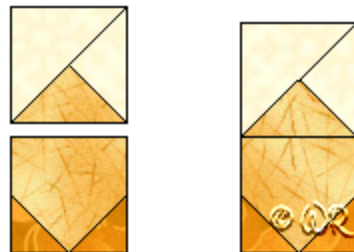


***Note:** You may wish to cut away excess fabric under visible triangles to reduce bulk
