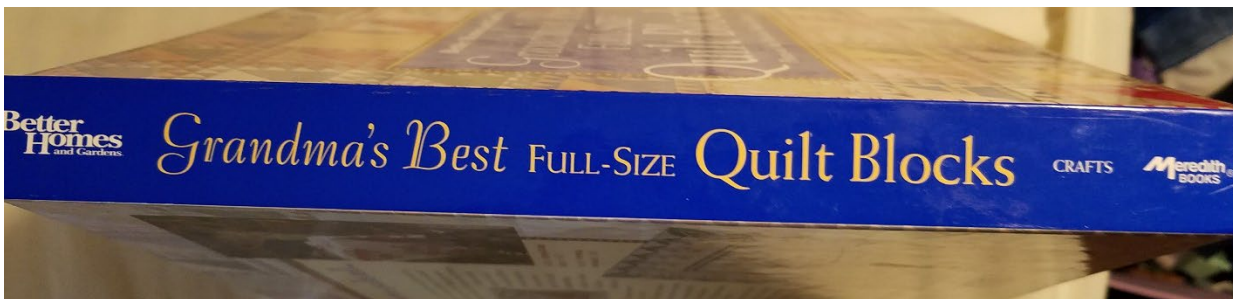

SHIPS OF MAINE VARIATION



There are 8 different pieces

A is a $2\frac{3}{4}$ square,

B is $2\frac{3}{4}$ square cut in half diagonally (or you can use a 3 Inch square instead which will assure that you don't lose your point)

C is $6\frac{3}{4} \times 2$

D is $2\frac{1}{2}$ square cut in half diagonally

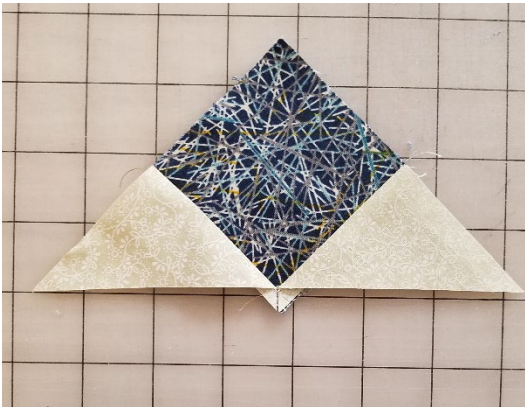
E is $3 \times 9\frac{1}{2}$

F is $4 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ make two of these

G 6 in. Square cut diagonally to form a triangle

H $2\frac{3}{4}$ inches each - 2 sets of 9 squares or use 5 sets of 3 inch squares to make $10\frac{3}{4}$ inch squares (2 per set of squares) whatever your preferred method is.

Sew B to A two times and trim



Sew D to C two times by placing D on top of C as a right angle on both sides and trim



Sew ABB to CDD and trim

Sew F to both sides of E by using previous method of right angle and trim as necessary

Sew ABBCDD to EFF



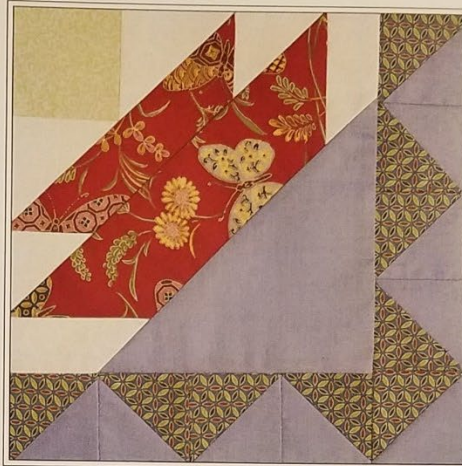
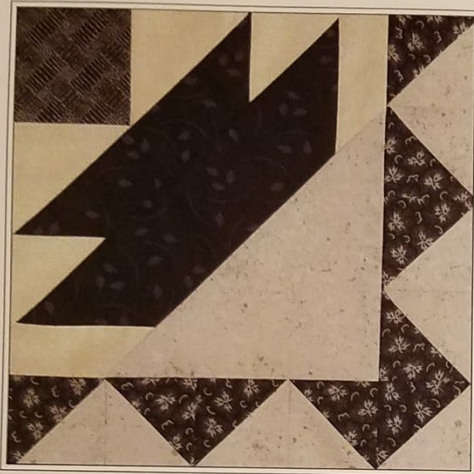
Sew G to ABBCDDEFF

Sew HH together by any method to make 2 ½ inch squares



Final Block is 9 ½ inch square

Ships of Maine Variation



These blocks are inspired by the antique quilt on page 11, top.



HOW TO CONSTRUCT THIS BLOCK

Sew B to A (2 times). Sew D to C (2 times). Stitch ABB to CDD. Sew F to E, add Fr. Sew ABBCDD to EFFr. Sew G to ABBCDDEFFr. Join two Hs (9 times). Sew four HH units together, noting color placement. Join to one side of ABBCDDEFFr. Sew five HH units together and stitch to the other side of unit.

HOW TO MAKE THIS QUILT

This quilt is designed to be a queen-size quilt measuring 90x99 inches, including a 4½-inch Zigzag border from page 204.
