

FILM AT SIX

Color 1 and 2 are blue, green, and teal jewel tones

Color 3 is black

Cut (1) 5.5-inch square of color 1

Cut (5) 2.5-inch squares of color 2

Cut (3) 1.5-inch by 2.5-inch rectangles of color 3

Cut (1) 1.5x5.5-inch of color 3

Cut (1) 1.5x8.5-inch of color 3



Part A

Sew 1x5.5-inch rectangle to one side of 5.5-inch square. Trim if needed. This is Part A.

Part B

Sew 2.5-inch square to black 2.5-inch rectangle, then sew 2.5 inch square to other side of rectangle ... pattern is: Color 2, color 3, color 2. This is Part B.

Sew Part B to the black rectangle on Part A.

Sew 8.5-inch rectangle of black to the right side of above assembly. (Color blocks should be pointed toward the top)

Part C

Sew 2.5-inch blue/green square to black rectangle then add another 2.5-inch blue/green square to other side of rectangle. Add a second black rectangle to the second blue/green square. Then add final 2.5-inch blue/green square to the second black rectangle. Pattern is color 2/black/color2/black/color2. This is part C.

Sew Part C to the right side of above assembly (along Black rectangle)

Final block is shown above.

When assembling the quilt, blocks can be turned $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$ turn from original layout to add some visual interest.

Sashing between blocks is 8.5x1.5 inches and between rows is also 1.5 inches ... length as needed.
