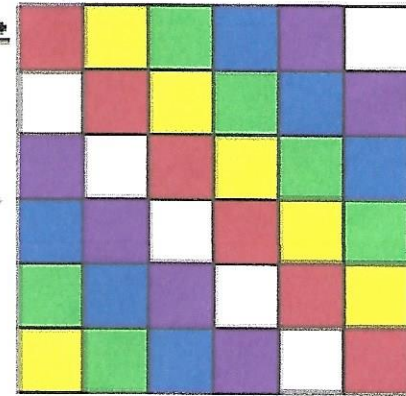
Block of the month December 2018

Multi Colored Bargello (12" finished)

All quilt blocks for the 2018-2019 guild year will be made in very bright colors of your choosing! All backgrounds will be either on white or white on white print.

Bring block to January meeting!

Cutting Instructions:

Colors A through E are any color and all should be different. Color F is background

Colors A, B, C, D, and E: Cut one 18"x 2½" rectangle of each color

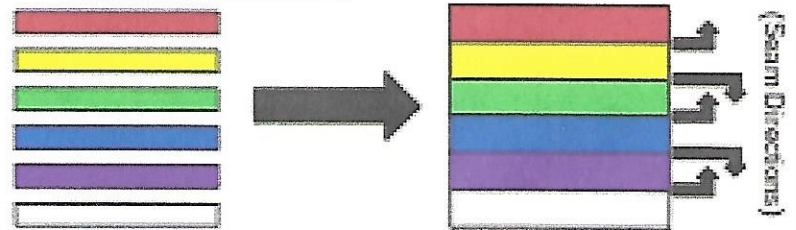
Color F: Make sure this is your white or your white on white background color.

Cut one 18"x 2½" rectangle

In the diagrams below, Color A=Red, Color B=Yellow, Color C=Green, Color D=Blue, Color E=Purple, and Color F=White.

Assembly Instructions:

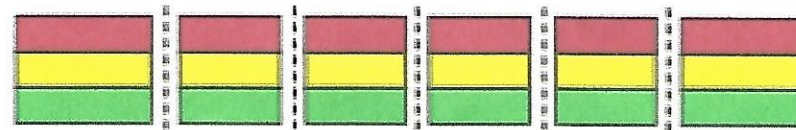
1) Sew strips together along the long edge to form a 13"x 18" (ish) rectangle. Press the Color A/B seam up, the Color B/C seam down, C/D seam up, etc. See diagram for more help.



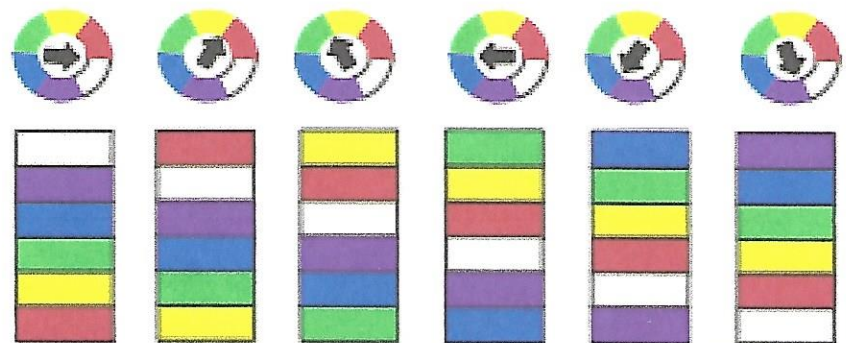
2) Sew Color A to Color F to connect the ends of the rectangle and make a tube-like shape. Press toward Color A.



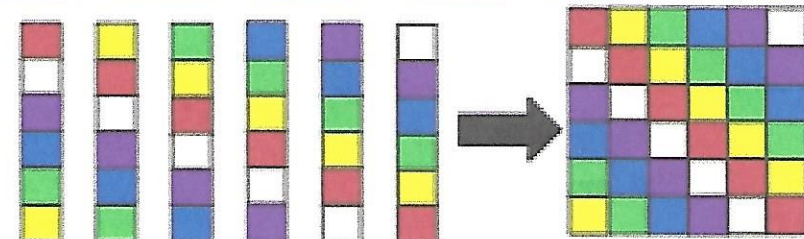
3) Flatten the tube and cut it into 6 - 2½" pieces. There will be extra on both ends.



4) Take out your seam ripper and unsew the seams on the tube to form a series of fabric strips. On your first strip, rip between Colors A&B, your second strip between Colors B&C, your third strip C&D, fourth D&E, fifth E&F, and sixth F&A. Note: arrange so that the colors form stairs as shown in the diagram.



5) Join the strips together. MAKE SURE Color A touches the next Color A on its corner, and all the colors do the same.



We suggest that you make two blocks. Keep one each month and you will have 9 to make a quilt by June. Submit the other one at the next meeting to the block raffle. Winner takes all each month! No need for another quilt? Stitch up the blocks into a quilt to donate to the Comfort Guild committee! We look forward to seeing your beautiful blocks! Katy & Sue
