

Block of the Month – Herring Run Quilt Guild

October 2019 – due at the November 2019 Guild Meeting

Fabric Required:

Purple Batik:

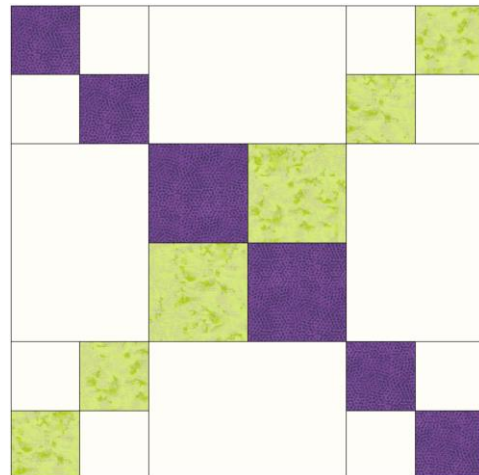
- Cut one 2" x 8" strip
- Cut two 3 1/2" squares

Green batik:

- Cut one 2" x 8" strip
- Cut two 3 1/2" squares

White (or white on white) fabric:

- Cut two 2" x 8" strips
- Cut four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

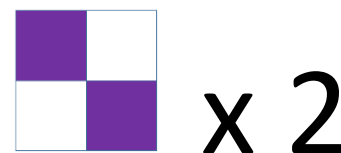


Assembly:

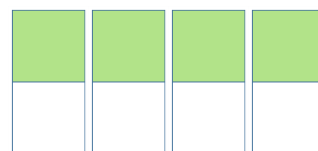
Sew the 2" x 8" purple strip to a 2" x 8" white strip with a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seam towards the purple. Subcut the strip into four 2" pieces.



Make two four patches.



Sew the 2" x 8" green strip to a 2" x 8" white strip with a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seam towards the green. Subcut the strip into four 2" pieces.



Make two four patches.



Take the 3 1/2" purple squares and 3 1/2" green squares and sew a four patch, using 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seams.

Following the diagram above, assemble the block.

Your block should measure 12 1/2" square.
